This form signed by both the Club President and the Club Secretary must reach the Secretary to the District Council at 6, York Gate, London NW1 4QG, not later than first post on Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> February 2006. Please note that late nominations will not be accepted. **The Candidate's CV must accompany this form. It should be returned with the nomination paper. A passport size photograph should also be enclosed. This will be used to assist clubs in identifying the candidate. Please note that there must be no personal statement seeking this office as this would constitute canvassing and is strictly forbidden.**

**NOTES**

Each Rotarian nominated as a District Governor must have been President of a member Club of Rotary International for a full term and must, on 30th June prior to taking office as District Governor on the 1st day of July, have served in the aggregate for at least seven years as a member in one or more clubs.

The candidate must in addition be an Active member of good standing of a Rotary Club in the same District as that of the proposing Club.

**THE MEMBERS PRIOR CONSENT TO ACT AS A DISTRICT GOVERNOR MUST FIRST HAVE BEEN OBTAINED AND IF THEY ARE NOT A MEMBER OF THE PROPOSING CLUB THEN THE CONCURRENCE OF THEIR CLUB MUST ALSO HAVE BEEN OBTAINED**
