

ROTARY CHARITY GOLF BREAKS.

The Rotary Club of Nailsea & Backwell, (D1100) near Bristol, are for the seventh year organising Golf Breaks to raise funds for Charity. These breaks that are of 2 nights duration with 3 rounds of golf, one of which is at the superb Rolls of Monmouth Golf Course, will again be held at Belmont, near Hereford, in June and August 2006. The cost is £183 per person sharing a twin/double bedded room.

The breaks are designed for Rotarians, their families and friends. Last year 123 people attended, with Rotarians from 8 Districts and 20 Rotary Clubs. As well as enjoying the fellowship, over £6,000 was raised for "Rotary's Africa Hope". This year both "Rotary Africa Hope" and "Mercy Ships" will be supported.
